Ahead of the 2024 legislative session, Mayors of the Caucus have formed a committee to address key issues and align with our policy priorities.

The first meeting of the Legislative Committee (LC) took place on 10/16/23. There was discussion around potential

bill material coming up including land use and zoning, TOD, transit funding, Prop 123, and accessing other federal funding pathways.

We are expecting to hear from one or two key legislators at the next meeting to provide feedback and better align our approach. This meeting is not confirmed yet, but expected to be in early November.
