Future Housing Coalition - Successful First Workshop on Missing Middle Housing



Last Friday, October 25th, Civic Results held the first full day workshop of the Future Housing Coalition on “Missing Middle Housing” to discuss housing that falls within 80% to 120% area median income (AMI). There were over forty attendees ranging from real estate professionals, housing policy analysts; government representatives from state, local and regional offices; and CU Denver faculty and students focused on middle housing.

Speakers such as Rodney Milton, Executive Director of Urban Land Institute Colorado (pictured right), provided context for the housing landscape we see in the metro Denver area as well as ways in

which we can ameliorate the lack of middle housing through changes to housing policy in the state. The workshop also featured student presentations from CU Denver’s Masters programs in Urban Design and Urban and Regional Planning.

The participants of the workshop signed up for various committees which will convene on a monthly basis through the winter and spring. The goal of the committees will be to build a toolkit aimed at local governments to more effectively and efficiently bring middle housing projects to their communities.
